



# Lucky

Kermit the frog said, "It's hard being green", but this piece is quite the opposite! We are lucky in love with all of these fantastic greens!

## **MATERIALS**

268 Milano Platter  
CN161-8 Light Wintergreen  
CN172-8 Bright Kelp  
CN173-8 Dark Kelp  
CN182-8 Bright Kiwi  
CN512-8 Green Apple

## **TOOLS**

R2170 Aqualon Filbert #4  
R2595 Aqualon Liner #4  
1" Painters Tape  
Assorted Royal Aqualon Brushes  
Pencil  
Scissors  
Sponge  
Water

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Lightly wipe ware with a damp sponge to prepare surface for painting.
2. Divide rim in half. Place tape on inside of rim. Cut corners of tape at an angle to fit. Place another border of tape on the inside rectangle.
3. Starting with the inset frame, paint 2-3 coats of Green Apple.
4. Sketch out three clovers using your pencil on the inside rectangle spacing them evenly apart. Write "Lucky" underneath the clovers. Trace clovers using an Aqualon Liner and Bright Kiwi, applying 2-3 coats. Trace "Lucky" using the Aqualon Liner and Dark Kelp.
5. Now we are going to paint the rim of the plate. Using the Aqualon Filbert and Light Wintergreen, apply a stroke of color at the bottom right corner of the piece. Skip about a 1/4" and create a new stroke using the Bright Kiwi. Next will be Dark Kelp, Green Apple, and then Bright Kelp. Continue doing this around the entire piece.
6. Dip in Pure Brilliance Glaze. Fire to Cone 06.
