



# December Delights

Festively dressed, this snowman cookie jar is the perfect holiday hostess gift - especially when filled with cookies!

## **MATERIALS**

1960 Snowman Jar  
BLS902-8 Apricot Stone  
BLS904-8 Strawberry Field  
BLS905-8 Snow Queen  
BLS908-8 Black Swan  
BLS909-8 Lollipop  
BLS918-8 Mint Shake  
BLS919-8 Mermaid's Song  
BLS920-8 Limelicious  
BLS921-8 Mad Hatter

## **SUPPLIES**

Assorted Royal Aqualon Brushes  
Detail Brush  
Water

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Lightly wipe ware with a damp sponge to prepare surface for painting.
2. Paint the scarf with 3-4 coats of Limelicious.
3. Add shading along the scarf edges and crevices by side loading a round brush with Mad Hatter and gliding it along the edges.  
  
Optional : Repeat the same shading technique in step #3 with Mermaid's Song to add shading along the crevices of the snowman body and along the hat brim.
4. Paint the stringed ends of the scarf with 2-3 coats of Mint Shake. Add detail lines within the crevices with Mermaid's Song. Let dry.
5. Paint the nose with a detail brush and Apricot Stone.
6. Paint each button with 2-3 coats of Black Swan.
7. Use a detail brush to fill in each eye. Add faint eyebrow lines with the same color, then add highlights to the eyes with Snow Queen dots.
8. Use 3 coats of Lollipop to paint circles on each cheek. Once painted, Trace over the mouth line with a slightly damp detail brush and Black Swan.
9. Paint the hat body and mittens with 3-4 coats of Strawberry Field. Repeat the shading technique in step #3 to add shading to the crevices with Black Swan. Let dry.
10. Dip in Colorobbia Super Clear Dipping Glaze and fire to Cone 06.
