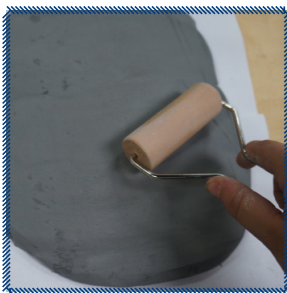


Confused about clay? We've got your answer!



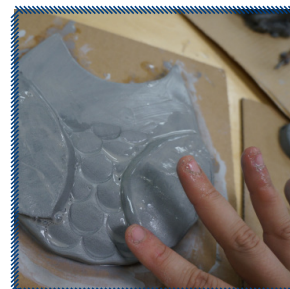
Below, we've outlined a simple step-by-step guide to getting started with clay:

1. **Create Shape** : Roll out clay slab approx. 1/2" thick, then cut out shape with a potter's needle or modeling tool.



TIP : Use a damp finger to smooth out edges.

2. **Decorate** : Create texture with decorating tools, or attach clay pieces together by slipping and scoring.



TIP : To attach clay pieces, score cross-hatch grooves onto each joining surface. Firmly press the scored surfaces together, then seal with watered-down clay.

3. **Paint** : Once clay has lost its shine, paint project with an assortment of Cover Coat paints.



TIP : For best results, paint 3-4 coats of each color and allow paint to dry in between coats.

3. **Glaze & Fire** : Fire completed projects in a kiln to a cone 04 firing temperature. For a glossy finish, dip fired project in Pure Brilliance Dipping Glaze and fire to cone 06 after the initial cone 04 firing.
