



Sea Urchin Bowl

Cool pastel shades come to life with Duncan True Matte Pastels. Use in conjunction with other glazes to achieve a piece with both matte and glossy looks.

MATERIALS

2597 Bread Bowl
BLS941-8 Baby Blue
HSS100 Grey Stardust
TM305-4 Minted
TM306-4 Baby Blues
FD258 Pure White

SUPPLIES

Assorted Paintbrushes
Water

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Lightly wipe ware with a damp sponge to prepare surface for painting.
2. On the outside of the bowl, paint the bottom half with 1 coat of Minted. Immediately paint the upper half with 1 coat of Baby Blues, then use a large damp paintbrush to blend the colors together where they meet.
3. Repeat step #2 2-3 additional times to achieve full paint coverage. Allow piece to dry.
4. Once dry, paint the inside of the bowl with 3-4 coats of Baby Blue. Let dry.
5. Paint the inside of the bowl with 1 coat of Grey Stardust to give the paint a shimmery overlay.
6. Using Pure White French Dimensions, create columns of raised dots along the outside of the bowl. Once complete, allow project to dry.
7. Fire completed project to Cone 06.
