BEFORE YOU BEGIN

PICK GLAZE - Are you more of a pink grapefruit gal? Or a lemony lady? Pick 3 or 4 colors and get them into squeezey bottles. I went for a retro fruit salad picking yellow, orange and green - but coral and pink for like.. a ruby red and light grapefruit shade are good too.

CUT YOUR STENCIL - print this sheet on cardstock and using an exacto knife, cut all the black portions off the stencil.

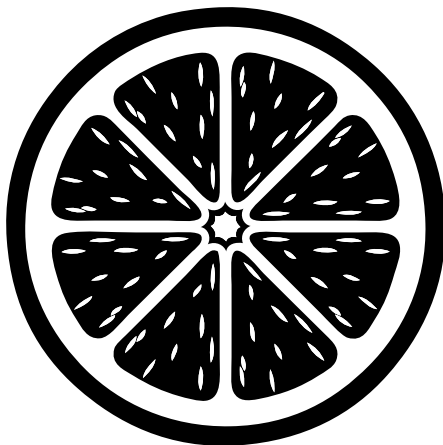
GLAZING

1. **INSIDE COLOR** - Pick your fav to go on the inside - squirt in, swish around and then you can sand the top.

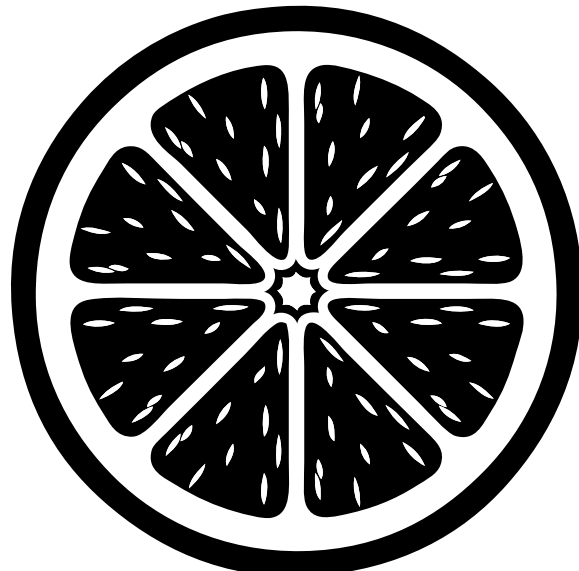
2. **DRAW STENCIL** - lightly using a pencil draw your stencil. Drawing out the stencil only gets tricky when you get to the end. When you are done drawing you then map out the colors. Y for yellow, O for Orange (you get the idea).

3. **FILL SEGMENTS** - not the rind. AMAZINGLY - you will probably mess this up. If you are teaching a class and aren't the one who messes this up - someone else will. Work in quarters so your color doesnt run.

4. **DO BACKGROUND COLOR** - Dare I say... easy peasy lemon squeezey? Circular movements with your squeezey bottle gets the job done.
